

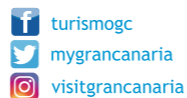
ECONOMIC AND FISCAL BENEFITS

No purchases will include VAT or any other special European taxes, just 7% local IGIC Canary tax. The low tax rate applied to certain products makes **their price between 10% and 30% cheaper than in the rest of Europe**. So perfumes, cosmetics, tobacco, alcohol, and to a lesser extent, electrical appliances and vehicles are highly competitive on the island in terms of price.
